Audition Preparations

- All auditioning students need to **prepare a 32 bar cut (1 min) of a song in the style of the show.** Bring sheet music clearly marked and in the correct key. No tracks, please. An accompanist will be provided.
- Come with a positive attitude, willing and ready for instruction.

Where to Find Sheet Music

- You can find most songs online at sheetmusicplus.com or musicnotes.com. On this website, you are able to purchase and download just one song's sheet music and print it on your home computer. This is usually between \$3-5.
- MR Music is located across Dorsett and has lots of sheet music for purchase
- The library also often has sheet music that you could use.

Dance Call

- A dance call will take place from 11:00am-12:00pm. No dance experience necessary.
- Please wear close fitting clothes you can move in well. These may be different from your individual audition attire. bring dance shoes if you have them.
- The dance audition will consist of ballet, jazz, and some folk dance movements.
- Some auditioners may not need to stay for the full dance call.

Callbacks

- Callbacks will be held from 1-6pm on April 8th. And will be posted on the bulletin board next to the rehearsal hall, the front desk and emailed to auditionees, by the end of the dance call.
 - Callbacks will consist of cold readings, and singing songs from the show.
 - If you are called back please familiarize yourself with the character's story and material.
 - Be aware that not all roles will have callbacks.

Character Breakdown

Mae Tuck- Female. Adult (40s). Mezzo-Soprano, A3-E5. Kind, and loving. Wife of Angus, and mother of Jesse and Miles. Feels stuck in life, and the monotony of her family's situation.

Angus Tuck- Male. Adult (40s). Tenor, E3-B4. Tired, and caring. Mae's husband, and father to Jesse and Miles. The Tuck family looks to him. Winnie reignites his fatherly instincts.

The Man in the Yellow Suit- Male. Adult (60s). Tenor, G3-B4. Conniving, motivated, and suspiciously knowledgeable. Herolder of the traveling circus, and a magician. Seeking a way to live forever, and will do anything for it. Knows about the Tucks and thinks they have the answer, and plans to make money off of the whole ordeal.

Winnie Foster- Female. 11. Soprano, A3-E5. Bold, adventurous, curious, daring, feisty and people pleasing. Betsy Foster's daughter, and Nana's granddaughter. Lost her father less than a year ago. Feels trapped under her mother's overprotection. Desperate for a friend and adventure.

Jesse Tuck- Male. 17. Tenor, F3-C5. Teasing, friendly, playful, adrenaline seeking, and prone to mischief. Overeager rule breaker. Trying to find his own kind of freedom.

Miles Tuck- Male. 21. Tenor, Baritone, F3-C5. Father and husband, but separated from his wife and kids, which has left him emotionally damaged. Has turned serious, and cynical. Brother to Jesse and Son of Mae and Angus. Fed up with the problems Jesse causes.

Constable Joe- Male. Adult (50s). Tenor, F3-B4. Cynical, dry, set in his ways, and thinks he always knows best. Not very bright, wants to maintain appearances. Deputy of Treetop. Hugo's father.

Betsy Foster- Female. Adult (late 30s). Mezzo-Soprano, A3-E5. Protective, overly cautious. Desperate to keep her daughter Winnie out of harm's way. Grieving widow. Owns the wood that the tucks live in.

Nana- Female. Adult (60s). Alto, A3- C#5/Db5. Playful and sarcastic. Winie's grandmother, and Betsy's mother.

Hugo- Male. 15. Tenor, G3-C5. Shy, nervous, eager to learn and prove himself. Smart, but overlooked. Son of Constable Joe.

Other characters (subject to alteration): Carny, Clown, Dancers, Circus Band, Dancer Mae, Dancer Angus, Dancer Pa, Fair Crowd, Thomas, Thomas' mother, Grown up Winnie, Young Boy, Young Girl.
